After a decade away, we are thrilled to announce our return to Honduras—marking a powerful new chapter in our mission to empower families and transform communities.

## **Harvest of Hope Center Honduras**

Building on the success of graduating 140 families across four former Agros villages, our new regional model—the Harvest of Hope Center (HHC)—is designed to serve more families, faster. By focusing on existing villages within a defined region, this model accelerates agribusiness development and significantly boosts farmers' productivity. It allows us to meet families where they are, delivering deeper impact in less time compared to our previous approach.

By 2028, our three HHCs across Central America aim to serve 800 to 1,000 new families. In Honduras, this initiative includes establishing a new village and extending support to six to eight surrounding communities—continuing our legacy of transformation through land ownership and sustainable livelihoods.
